


Preparation for Adulthood for Young people with SEND

2023

This publication includes participation and destination measures, including the proportion of 16-17 year olds with SEN participating in education or training and the proportion recorded as NEET (not in education, employment or training); the percentage of pupils by SEN provision group continuing to a sustained education, apprenticeship or employment destination in the year after completing key stage 4 study (after year 11) and key stage 5 study (after year 13).

Accommodation and employment status for adults (aged 18-64) with a learning disability is also included in this report. These measures are taken from the Adult Social Care Outcomes Framework.



% 16-17 year olds with EHCPs recorded as participating in education and/or training






NEET aged 16-17



% 16-17 year olds with EHCPs recorded as NEET or not known













KS4 Destinations




% of KS4 with EHCPs going to, or remaining in education & employment/training overall (mainstream and special schools)














% of KS5 with identified SEN in education, employment or training at 17 (2017/18 to 2021/22)









% of KS5 in sustained education, apprenticeship or employment (2021/22 Academic year)
