

Outcomes for Pupils with SEND

This publication provides data on attainment outcomes for Early Years, Phonics, Maths Multiplication Check, Key Stage 2 and Key Stage 4 by SEN category.

Also included is Level 2 (5 GCSEs 9-4 or equivalent) and Level 3 (2 A levels or equivalent) Attainment at age 19.

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
Level 2 with English and Maths at Age 19

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

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What the Data Tells Us


- Pupils with SEN Support continue to achieve below all comparators in Early Years. In contrast to national trends, the East Riding saw a 3.1% drop in the proportion of SEN support achieving a good level of development. The gap therefore between SEN support attainment in the East Riding and that seen nationally has widened from 1.5% below national in 2023 to 5.2% below in 2024.
- Pupils with EHCPs continue to achieve above all comparators in Early Years, however the gap has significantly decreased due to the 5.5% drop in attainment since 2023. The gap between EHCP attainment in the East Riding and that seen nationally has decreased from 6.4% above national in 2023 to 0.9% above in 2024.

% of SEN Support achieving Expected Standard in Phonics in Y1



What the Data Tells Us


- The East Riding has seen a large increase in the proportion of pupils at SEN support achieving the expected standard in phonics. Whilst still below all comparators, the gap between East Riding and national attainment for SEN support in phonics has reduced from 7.9% below national in 2023 to 3.6% below in 2024.
- In contrast to national trends, the East Riding has seen a decrease in EHCP phonics attainment from the previous year. Despite a 6.7% decrease from 2023, pupils with EHCPs in East Riding schools continue to achieve above all comparators in phonics attainment.

% of SEN Support achieving the Expected Standard in RWM at KS2



What the Data Tells Us


- Following national trends, the East Riding saw an increase from the previous year in the proportion of SEN support pupils achieving the expected standard in RWM combined. The gap between national and LA attainment has widened; East Riding now sits 7% below national for KS2 RWM attainment at SEN support, compared to 5.2% below in 2023.
- As seen in EYFS and phonics attainment for EHCP pupils, KS2 attainment data shows a dip from the previous year but still remains higher than all comparators. In 2023 the East Riding sat 5.8% above national for EHCP attainment in KS2 RWM combined; this gap has reduced to the East riding being 3.3% above in 2024.

% of SEN Support achieving the Expected Standard in Reading at KS2



What the Data Tells Us


- The proportion of pupils with SEN support achieving the expected standard in reading saw a 7.0% increase from the previous year. Due to this significant increase, which was much higher than the increases seen nationally and regionally, the East Riding is above regional and statistical neighbours for reading attainment at SEN support and largely in line with national proportions.
- Despite the 1.5% decrease from 2023, the proportion of pupils with EHCPs achieving the expected standard in reading continues to be well above all comparators. The gap between national and East Riding attainment has however reduced from 9.2% above national in 2023 to 6.6% above in 2024.

% of SEN Support achieving the Expected Standard in Writing at KS2



What the Data Tells Us

- The proportion of pupils with SEN support achieving the expected standard in writing saw a 1.2% increase from the previous year. Due to this increase being less than the increase seen nationally, the gap between East Riding and national SEN support writing attainment has widened by a further 1% with the East Riding now 7.4 percentage points below the national comparator.
- Despite the 3.7% decrease from 2023, the proportion of pupils with EHCPs achieving the expected standard in writing continues to be above all comparators. The gap between national and East Riding attainment has however reduced from 7.6% above national in 2023 to 3.5% above in 2024.






KS2 Maths Attainment

● East Riding ● National ● Statistical Neighbours ● Yorkshire and Humber





What the Data Tells Us


- The proportion of pupils with SEN support achieving the expected standard in maths saw a 3.6% increase from the previous year. Due to this increase, which was higher than the increases seen nationally and regionally, the East Riding is now above statistical neighbours for reading attainment at SEN support and in line with regional proportions.
- Despite the 4.1% decrease from 2023, the proportion of pupils with EHCPs achieving the expected standard in maths continues to be above all comparators. The gap between national and East Riding attainment has however reduced from 9.3% above national in 2023 to 4.4% above in 2024.



What the Data Tells Us


- Following national and regional trends the average multiplication check score achieved by pupils at SEN support rose from the previous year. Despite the 0.8 increase, the East Riding still remains below all comparators for SEN support achievement in the Year 4 multiplication check and the gap between national and East Riding attainment has largely stayed the same (1 mark below).
- In contrast to regional, national and statistical neighbour trends, the East Riding has seen a reduction in the average score achieved in the multiplication check for pupils with EHCPs. The 2024 average score of 13.7 places the East Riding below all comparators.



What the Data Tells Us


- The average attainment 8 score for pupils with SEN support in East Riding schools saw a 2.5 points decrease from the previous year; a greater decrease than that seen nationally and placing the East Riding below all comparators for 2024 attainment 8 measure.
- Pupils with an EHCP in East Riding schools had an average attainment 8 score of 19.4 in 2024; a 0.8 point decrease from 2023 and in contrast to the 0.2 points increase in attainment for EHCP pupils nationally. Despite the decrease, attainment 8 for EHCP pupils in East Riding schools continues to be well above all comparators.



What the Data Tells Us


- The average progress 8 score for pupils with SEN support in East Riding schools saw a 0.27 points decrease from the previous year; a contrast to national and regional trends that saw little or no change from 2023, and placing the East Riding below all comparators for the 2024 progress 8 measure.
- In contrast to national and regional trends for average progress 8, pupils with an EHCP in East Riding schools saw a slight increase from the previous year. As with the average attainment 8 score, progress 8 for EHCP pupils in East Riding schools continues to be well above all comparators.






Level 2 Attainment at Age 19

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What the data tells us

Attainment of Level 2 equates to achievement of 5 or more GCSEs at grades 9-4 or a Level 2 vocational qualification of equivalent size. The percentage of the SEN cohort studying in East Riding of Yorkshire at the age of 16 (academic age 15) who attain a Level 2 qualification by the age of 19 in 2023, is 64.8%, slightly less than the national figure of 66.0%. The percentage of the EHCP cohort studying in the East Riding who attained a Level 2 qualification by age 19 saw a significant drop of 13.6 percentage points from the previous year. Despite this drop, Level 2 attainment for the EHCP cohort is still well above the regional and national comparator.







Level 2 Attainment with English and Maths at Age 19



Level 2 Attainment with English and Maths for pupils with SEN

What the data tells us


The percentage of the SEN cohort studying in East Riding of Yorkshire at the age of 16 (academic age 15) who attain a Level 2 qualification, including English and Maths, by the age of 19 has increased at a greater rate than comparators, closing the gap between national and local authority performance. This compares to those with an EHCP of which 25.5% attained a Level 2 qualification, including English and Maths; despite the drop in performance from the previous year, this figure is still well above national and regional comparators.



What the data tells us

Attainment at Level 3 equates to achievement of 2 or more A-levels or equivalent Level 3 vocational qualification. The charts above show that the percentage of the SEN cohort studying in East Riding of Yorkshire at the age of 16 (academic age 15) who attain a level 3 by the age of 19 is 30.3%. Whilst this figure is still below the national comparator; the gap has reduced from 7 percentage points in 2022 to 5.6 points in 2023. As with Level 2 attainment, the EHCP cohort studying in East Riding of Yorkshire at the age of 16 (academic age 15) who attain a level 3 by the age of 19 saw a drop from the previous year but still remains above national and regional comparators.
