This publication provides data on attainment outcomes for Early Years, Phonics, Maths Multiplication Check, Key Stage 2 and Key Stage 4 by SEN category.

Also included is Level 2 (5 GCSEs 9-4 or equivalent) and Level 3 (2 A levels or equivalent) Attainment at age 19.





What the Data Tells Us


- Pupils with SEN Support continue to achieve below all comparators in Early Years; however the 3.9 percentage points increase in attainment from the previous year has significantly reduced the gap between national and local authority attainment EYFS SEN Support attainment and the 2025 figure of 23.6% is largely in line with the regional comparator.
- EHCP attainment at EYFS stage has had some pronounced peaks and troughs over the last four years which is in contrast to the national profile which has remained consistently around 4% over the last few years. Despite the erratic trend line the proportion of EHCP pupils achieving a good level of development at the end of the early years foundation stage continues to remain well above all comparators.

What the Data Tells Us


- Largely down to the peaks and troughs in EHCP attainment, the EYFS attainment for all SEN children in the East Riding has also had a high degree of variability over the last few years.
- 2025 attainment for all SEN children at the end of early years foundation stage in East Riding is in line with statistical neighbours and largely in line with regional proportions.
- The gap between national and local authority attainment has significantly decreased from 5.3 percentage points below national in 2024 to 1.9 points below in 2025.

% of SEN Support achieving Expected Standard in Phonics in Y1



What the Data Tells Us


- The East Riding has seen a large increase in the proportion of pupils at SEN support achieving the expected standard in phonics. Whilst still below all comparators, the gap between East Riding and national attainment for SEN support in phonics has reduced from 3.6% below national in 2024 to 2.5% below in 2025.
- 2025 Phonics attainment for pupils with EHCPs in the East Riding has large stayed the same from the previous year and continues to be above all comparators. ;

What the Data Tells Us


- Phonics attainment for all pupils with SEN in the East Riding has seen a 1.1% increase from the previous year; this is in contrast to national and regional trends which have both seen a decline in attainment from the previous year.
- Over the last two years there has been a measurable reduction in the phonics attainment gap between national and East Riding SEN pupils; from 3.5 percentage points in 2024 to 1.7 percentage points in 2025.

% of SEN Support achieving the Expected Standard in RWM at KS2



What the Data Tells Us


- Following national trends, the East Riding saw an increase from the previous year in the proportion of SEN support pupils achieving the expected standard in RWM combined. The gap between national and LA attainment has widened; East Riding now sits 9.1% below national for KS2 RWM attainment at SEN support, compared to 7.0% below in 2024.
- KS2 RWM combined attainment for EHCP pupils shows a dip from the previous year but still remains higher than all comparators. The attainment gap between the national and East Riding RWM figure has reduced from 3.3 percentage points above in 2024 to 2.2 points above in 2025.

% of SEN Support achieving the Expected Standard in Reading at KS2



What the Data Tells Us


- The proportion of pupils with SEN support achieving the expected standard in reading saw a 3.9% decrease from the previous year which is in contrast to national and regional trends which both saw an increase. This places East Riding attainment for pupils with SEN Support 7.3 percentage points below the national comparator in 2025.
- Despite the 2.1% decrease from 2024, the proportion of pupils with EHCPs achieving the expected standard in reading continues to be above all comparators. The gap between national and East Riding attainment has however reduced from 6.6% above national in 2024 to 4.1% above in 2025.



What the Data Tells Us


- Improved outcomes in reading, writing and maths combined for the SEN support pupils and the reduction in RWM attainment for pupils with an EHCP has led to stable outcomes for the overall SEN cohort.
- Decreases in reading attainment for both SEN support pupils and EHCP pupils has led to a 3.8% decrease in reading attainment for the overall SEN cohort in 2025.

% of SEN Support achieving the Expected Standard in Writing at KS2



What the Data Tells Us


- The proportion of pupils with SEN support achieving the expected standard in writing saw a 0.9% increase from the previous year. Due to this increase being less than the increase seen nationally, the gap between East Riding and national SEN support writing attainment has widened with the East Riding now 9.0 percentage points below the national comparator.
- Pupils with EHCPs achieving the expected standard in writing continues to be above all comparators. The gap between national and East Riding attainment has however reduced from 3.5 above national in 2024 to 2.6% above in 2025.

% of SEN Support achieving the Expected Standard in Maths at KS2



What the Data Tells Us

- The proportion of pupils with SEN support achieving the expected standard in maths saw a 3.3% decrease from the previous year. The gap between East Riding and national attainment in maths for pupils with SEN support has increased from 2.5 percentage points in 2024 to 8.9 points in 2025.
- The proportion of pupils with EHCPs achieving the expected standard in maths continues to be above all comparators. The gap between national and East Riding attainment has widened from East Riding attainment being 4.4 percentage points above national in 2024 to 6.3 above in 2025.






KS2 All SEN Pupils Attainment

● East Riding ● National ● Statistical Neighbours ● Yorkshire and Humber





What the Data Tells Us


- Improved outcomes in writing for both the SEN support pupils and pupils with an EHCP has led to a 0.5% increase in the writing attainment for all pupils with SEN.
- Despite an increase in the maths attainment for pupils with EHCPs, a 3.3% decrease in maths attainment for pupils at SEN support has resulted in a 2.1% decrease in maths attainment for the overall SEN cohort in 2025.






Year 4 Multiplication Check

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What the Data Tells Us


- Following national and regional trends the average multiplication check score achieved by pupils at SEN support rose from the previous year. The 1.3 increase places the East Riding above statistical neighbours and brings SEN support attainment more in line with national and regional multiplication check average scores.
- There has been a significant increase in the average score achieved in the multiplication check for pupils with EHCPs in 2025 and the East Riding's average score of 15.3 is above regional and statistical neighbours scores and is only 0.3 pts below the national average score.

What the Data Tells Us


- Due to the significant increase in the average score for both SEN support and EHCP pupils, the average score for all SEN pupils in the East Riding is now above statistical neighbours average score and largely in line with national and regional comparators.



What the Data Tells Us


- The average attainment 8 score for pupils with SEN support in East Riding schools saw a 2.8 points increase from the previous year; a greater increase than that seen nationally and regionally. This has reduced the gap between national and local authority attainment from 3.7 below national in 2024 to 1.5 percentage points below in 2025.
- Pupils with an EHCP in East Riding schools had an average attainment 8 score of 22.7 in 2025; a 3.3 point increase from 2024. This was a much greater increase than that seen at a national and regional level and continues to place East Riding well above all comparators for attainment 8 for pupils with an EHCP.







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What the Data Tells Us


Progress measures will not be published for the 2024/25 and 2025/26 academic years as KS4 pupils in these years did not have KS2 assessments due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

- The average progress 8 score for pupils with SEN support in East Riding schools saw a 0.27 points decrease from the previous year; a contrast to national and regional trends that saw little or no change from 2023, and placing the East Riding below all comparators for the 2024 progress 8 measure.
- In contrast to national and regional trends for average progress 8, pupils with an EHCP in East Riding schools saw a slight increase from the previous year. As with the average attainment 8 score, progress 8 for EHCP pupils in East Riding schools continues to be well above all comparators.




KS4 Attainment for CYPs with Any SEN in State-funded Schools

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What the Data Tells Us


Progress measures will not be published for the 2024/25 and 2025/26 academic years as KS4 pupils in these years did not have KS2 assessments due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

- Pupils with any special educational needs include those with SEN support or an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) in the East Riding in 2024 achieved a higher average attainment 8 score than national and regional comparators in 2025.




Level 2 Attainment at Age 19

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What the data tells us


Attainment of Level 2 equates to achievement of 5 or more GCSEs at grades 9-4 or a Level 2 vocational qualification of equivalent size. The percentage of the SEN Support cohort studying in East Riding of Yorkshire at the age of 16 (academic age 15) who attain a Level 2 qualification by the age of 19 in 2024, is 67.3%, this is above the national figure of 64.9%. The percentage of the EHCP cohort studying in the East Riding who attained a Level 2 qualification by age 19 in 2024 is 37.9% which continues to be above the national comparator of 29.8%. For both CYPs with SEN support and EHCPs, attainment of Level 2 in the East Riding improved from the previous year; a contrast to national and regional comparators that both saw a decrease.






Level 2 Attainment with English and Maths at Age 19

What the data tells us


Following national and regional trends, the percentage of pupils at SEN support and with an EHCP studying in East Riding of Yorkshire at the age of 16 who attain a Level 2 qualification including English and Maths by the age of 19 has decreased from the previous year. CYPs with SEN Support saw a much more significant drop (6.2% decrease) than seen nationally and attainment at Level 2 with English and maths now sits below the national comparator for this cohort. Attainment at Level 2 with English and Maths for pupils with EHCPs in the East Riding still sits above all comparators but the gap between national and East Riding attainment has significantly decreased over the last 4 years.






Level 3 Attainment at Age 19

What the data tells us

Attainment at Level 3 equates to achievement of 2 or more A-levels or equivalent Level 3 vocational qualification. Trends in Level 3 attainment very much mirrors the same trends seen with Level 2 attainment with English and Maths. For pupils at both SEN support and with an EHCP at all geographical levels, including in the East Riding, there has been a decrease from the previous year. Attainment at Level 3 for pupils at SEN support continues to sit below the national LA comparator but is in line with the regional figure. In contrast, EHCP attainment at Level 3 continues to sit above all comparators, but as with Level 2 attainment, the gap between national and LA attainment has significantly reduced over the last four years
