Overall, health and wellbeing outcomes for the East Riding (based on the indicators used by Fingertips for their local authority profiles) are significantly better or similar to the England average. Those that were significantly worse (in this version of the document) included suicide rate, the estimated dementia diagnosis rate (aged 65 and older) and the overweight (including obesity) prevalence in adults.
